



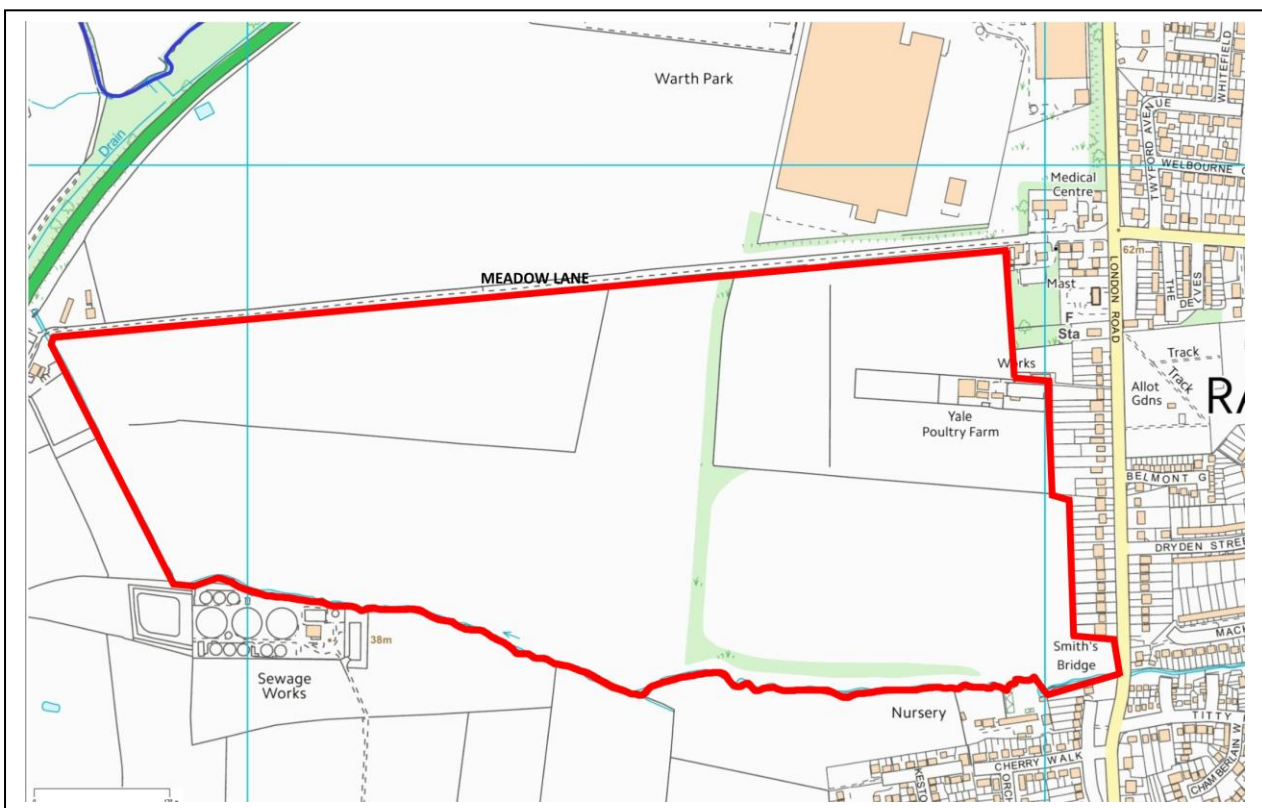
# RAUNDS TOWN COUNCIL

## GREEN SPACE SOUTH OF MEADOW LANE TO HOGS DYKE

Raunds Town Council are preparing a Neighbourhood Plan. The Neighbourhood Plan gives the community real power over future planning for our town.

The Town Council undertook a consultation exercise on the Neighbourhood Plan in December 2015. We received many responses and your comments have been reviewed and changed accordingly.

However we would still like to get a more detailed understanding of local peoples' views on one particular area. This is the area of land lying south of Meadow Lane to Hogs Dyke, outlined in red on the map below.



The Town Council want to make sure the Neighbourhood Plan fully represents the views of local residents. In the Neighbourhood Plan the area outlined in red has been designated as local green space. However the developers of Warth Park have suggested that the land could be used to extend Warth Park.
