

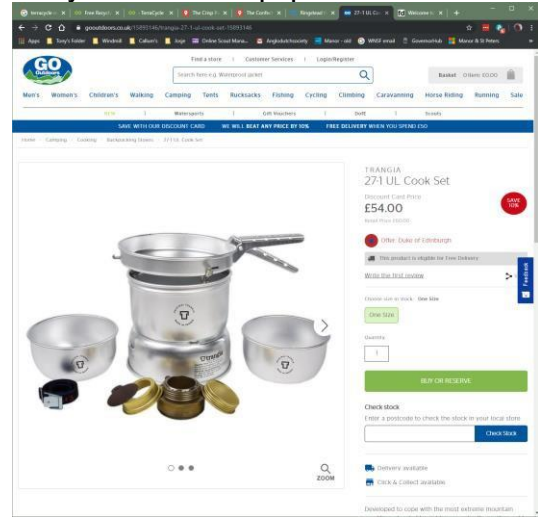

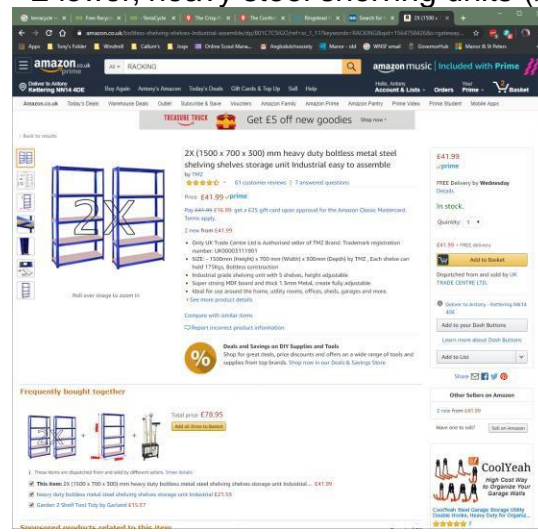
How would the grant be used?

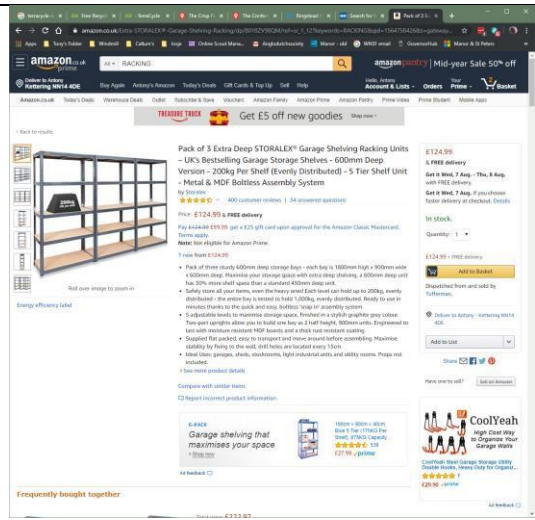
- 4 lightweight cooking sets (£216) – for our Scouts when they go on Expedition and need to carry their own equipment



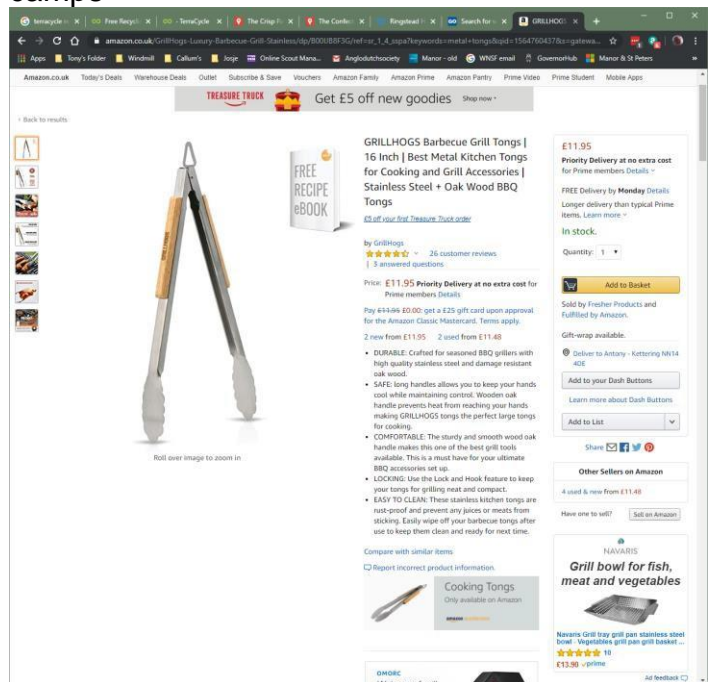
- 2 lower, heavy steel shelving units (£42)



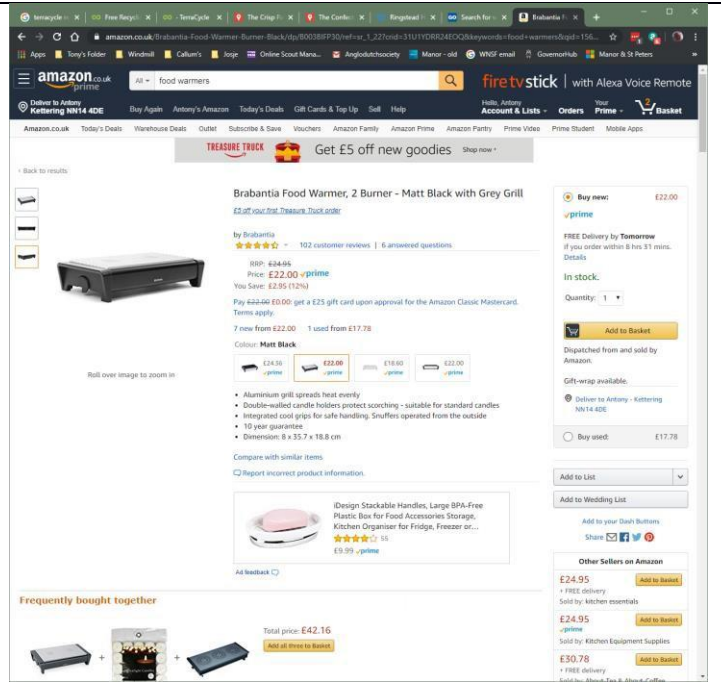
- 3 higher, extra deep heavy steel shelving units (£125)



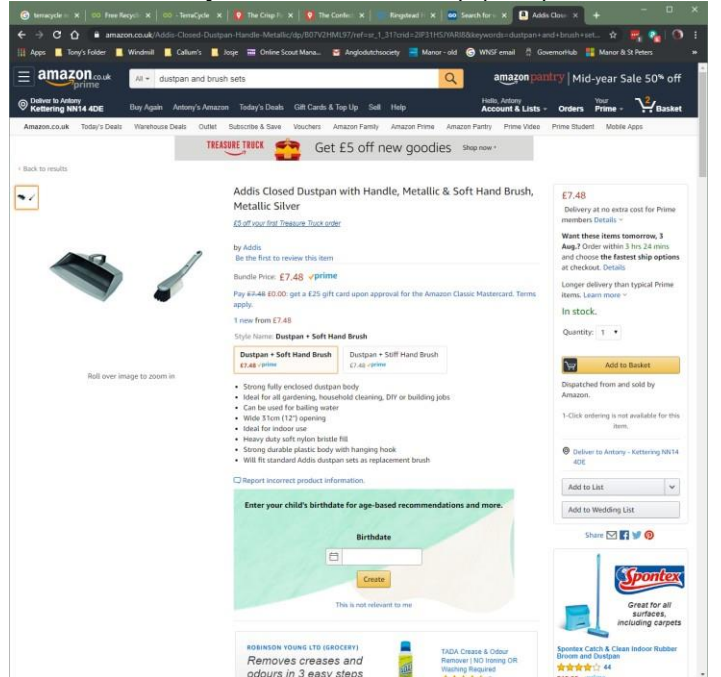
- 3 cooking utensils (metal tongs) (£36) – so we keep our cooks safe when they are cooking at camps



- 2 food warmers (to keep our camp food warmer, rather than balancing it on top of our water cooler) (£44)



- 2 durable dustpan and brush sets (to clean the tents after they have been used) (£15)
