Hi Kate

I am pleased to inform you that Raunds have been selected to take part in the 2019 Community Speed Watch programme. You are paired with Ringstead.

The training for any new volunteers or those wishing a refresher will take place on Saturday 23rd March 2019, between 0930hrs – 1215hrs (approx.) at Caroline Chisholm School, Wooldale Road, Northampton, NN4 6TP.

There are other training sessions throughout 2019 if you have new volunteers that can't make this date.

I have also attached a template for recruiting volunteers, for you to use/edit, as required.

The speed device and associated equipment will be delivered to Raunds on 30th March 2019. The equipment is then exchanged between yourselves and your paired group on alternate weeks over the 6 week period. The equipment will be collected from Ringstead on the 11th May 2019.

Additional time with the equipment

CSW+ was created to allow communities further periods of time with the enforcement equipment. Each trained community can request up to two further fortnightly sessions during the CSW enforcement window (Feb – Oct). There should be a period of 30 days between sessions; this includes the main six week block. These sessions are additional activity and do not receive further data collection before and after. Should you wish to request an additional session you should contact myself as the programme lead. Places are limited and will be on a first come first served basis.

Parish Boards

These boards are **lent** to your Community, whilst they remain in the scheme, (image of similar attached). Please avoid displaying the Parish Boards whilst carrying out your speed checks. These signs very quickly become ineffective if left in the same places for much longer than 6 weeks. Without change, the sign can become invisible. It's almost the fire extinguisher in the corner of the room type effect (you see it but it doesn't register because you simply expect it to be there).
